
Short History

Founded in March 1993 as a non-governmental and non-profiting organization, **USEFUL to ALBANIAN WOMEN (UAW)** is one of the pioneering associations in the field of social and humanitarian service, in Albania., based in Tirana, dedicated to empower women and children by advancing their basic human rights and promoting equality

UAW is one of the oldest NGO's founded by a group of independently minded women who were eager to provide some kind of practical assistance to disadvantaged Albanian women and children (B.Sterland)

During years,

UAW has grown in size , quantity and quality, and made significant efforts to build management and administrative capacities. The whole activity of UAW has been re-conceptualized within a longer-term nationally oriented framework

Who is involve as beneficiary, actor and decision maker

- 10 UAW trainers and lecturers that will be prepared to train on the TOT
- The civil society community in Albania, of which UAW is an active actor;
- The general public, especially women's movement which is interested for professional experts, organization and a vivid society.

Where we are?


The geographical expansion of the building up women's leadership, through different ways as establishing women's clubs in other Albanian cities reinforcing youth initiatives etc
